Chamblee Wheels Out  
 Once-a-Week  
 Sanitation Service

**O**n July 1, Chamblee Public Works wheels out sanitation services for the newly annexed area of the City which includes the areas south of Peachtree-DeKalb Airport to the I-85 access road; east from the Doraville city limits and west to the Brookhaven city limits.

Chamblee residents are being provided with 95-gallon roll carts for garbage, free of charge, unless they previously requested a smaller garbage cart. Recycle roll carts are also available by request. If you did not pre-order your choice of sanitation carts on-line or by phone prior to June 1 and wish to make

changes to what you received you will need to complete a change request form on-line or call Public Works at 770-986-5040.

# Q&A

## **Who do I contact with questions about my new sanitation services?**

## **How do I start sanitation services?**

Just start using your new 95-gallon cart and roll it out to the street. If you are new to Chamblee, then register with the Public Works Department either online at [chambleega.gov](http://chambleega.gov) or by phone at 770-986-5040.

## **Do I have to participate?**

Yes. Residential sanitation services are mandatory. This service is included in the residential property owner's annual tax bill. Recycling, however, is optional and free.

## **What do I do with my existing sanitation and/or recycling bin?**

The DeKalb County sanitation and recycling bins are property of the County. They will be responsible for

retrieval of these bins. You can contact DeKalb County Sanitation at (404) 294-2900.

## **Can the cart be used for other purposes?**

No. Your cart is assigned to your address for garbage or recycling collection only. Don't use it to move heavy objects. If your cart is missing or needs repair, contact Public Works at 770-986-5040.

## **Do I need to bag my garbage?**

Yes. All garbage must be bagged and securely tied prior to being placed inside the cart. This will keep the cart clean, minimize odors and insects, and prevent loose material from falling into the street during collection.

## **Do I need to bag or separate my recycling?**

No, you do not need to bag or separate recyclables. Chamblee Sanitation provides single-stream recycling to its residents. Single-stream means that the resident does not have to sort the recycled materials. Residents may place all acceptable recyclable materials in a single container for pickup.

## **What can be recycled?**

Paper, glass, metal, and plastic materials. For a full list visit [chambleega.gov](http://chambleega.gov).

## **What do I do with my electronics?**

In our continuing effort to reduce landfill use and promote responsible re-use of electronic waste, electronic items can be brought to the Public Works facility at 3210 Cumberland Dr. for proper disposal. This facility accepts electronic items only on the third Saturday of each month from 8 a.m. until 12 noon. See [chamblee.gov](http://chamblee.gov) for a detailed list of approved electronics.

## **Will Chamblee continue to provide bulky item and appliance pickup service?**

Yes. Public Works will continue to provide special pickups of bulky items for a fee. Construction debris, trees, dirt, rock, concrete, over-sized tree limbs, appliances, and other large items are considered special pickups. Call the Public Works Department at 770-986-5040 to schedule a pickup.

## **Who owns the cart? What happens if my cart is damaged or stolen?**

Carts are the property of the City of Chamblee Public Works and are provided to customers as a part of residential sanitation services. If your cart is damaged or missing, contact Chamblee Public Works.
