

Chamblee's Georgia Cities Week Scavenger Hunt

Welcome to the hunt!

As a way to celebrate Georgia Cities Week, Chamblee has hidden artifacts all over the city in historic or significant places that allow you to explore the great city of Chamblee. These artifacts, known commonly as 'geocaches', are found using a combination of GPS coordinates, contextual clues and your own smarts. Each geocache is a durable, weatherproof container of a variable size that contains; 1) writing utensil, 2) a log to sign, and 3) a chit to collect and bring to the Family Field Day at Dresden Park on April 23 to redeem for prizes and swag. There are 7 caches hidden throughout the city, their GPS coordinates and clues can be found at www.chambleega.com/cachelocations.

In order to play, you'll need:

A GPS device or smartphone with free GPS/Compass app (such as the one installed on every iOS device or a free waypoint navigator app)

Some basic facts about Chamblee

Your smarts

A commitment to discretion and preservation of the area of the cache (to keep it secret, fun and safe for those who come behind you).

Rules:

Caches are located on public property or property with permission of the land owner. You will not need to pass through any fence, gate or other restricted/locked property to find the caches.

Preserve the natural area and leave no trace. You will not need to dig or otherwise disturb the natural landscape to find the caches, though you may need to feel and look very carefully.

Be discreet. Most people won't know what you are doing and you don't want to look weird! Be discreet to keep the cache a secret and preserve the fun for those who come after you.

You can claim your prize(s) at Family Field Day at Dresden Park on April 23rd at the Info Tent. Unclaimed prizes from Family Field Day may be claimed at the Chamblee Civic Center April 25-29 before 5pm.

Prizes are limited and available on a first come, first serve basis. Once the chits are claimed or the Cities Week ends, it's game over.

Prizes:

Every cache you find is a treasure trove of both the natural beauty and historic significance of Chamblee, our residents, and businesses. However, each cache also contains a unique chit, a token representing your find, that you'll need to collect and bring to the Info Tent at Family Field Day on April 23rd to earn bigger and better prizes. The amount of chits available is limited so claim yours while you can to earn fabulous prizes. (Unclaimed prizes from Family Field Day may be claimed at the Chamblee Civic Center April 25-29 before 5pm).
