

SECOND AMENDMENT TO EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Second Amendment") is entered by and between the City of Chamblee, Georgia, a political subdivision of the State of Georgia (hereinafter "City") and Jonathan Walker (hereinafter "Walker" and sometimes "City Manager), collectively referred to as the "Parties,"

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and Walker entered into that certain EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT executed by the Parties on September 28, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2018, the aforesaid EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT was amended by that certain FIRST AMENDMENT TO EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT which increased City Manager's compensation and benefits; and

WHEREAS, since the date of said FIRST AMENDMENT TO EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT, the City, through its Mayor and City Council, has evaluated the performance of the City Manager and based on the performance of the City Manager over the period from September 5, 2018 to the date of this SECOND AMENDMENT it is the consensus of the governing body that the City provide an increase in the annual compensation for the City Manager.


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises as set forth in this SECOND AMENDMENT and the original EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT, as amended, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1.

Section 2: Salary and Evaluation shall be amended by deleting subparagraph A. of said Section 2 and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

A. For the performance of services pursuant to the Employment Agreement, as amended, the City agrees to pay City Manager an annual base salary of \$175,000.00, payable in installments consistent with the City's regular payroll practices. Said base salary amount shall be paid retroactively effective with the pay period beginning on November 22, 2019.
