

**CITY OF CHAMBLEE
SANITATION SPECIAL PICKUP REQUEST**

PURPOSE AND GOAL

Special pickups (SPUs) are scheduled for bulky items that are unable to be collected as a part of your regular sanitation services. These items may include furniture, appliances, construction debris, large brush piles, trees, mulch, rock, sand, dirt, etc. Residents may submit their special pickup requests via the call center, email, MyChamblee, and the [City website](#), where they will be directed to fill out the [Special Pickup Form](#). The Sanitation Department will collect the SPU within one business day after complete payment is made. The special pickup fees are as described below:

FEES

<i>Category</i>	<i>Fee</i>
<i>Up to 3 items OR items less than 100 lbs. a piece</i>	No Fee
<i>More than 3 items, items exceeding 100 lbs. OR large brush/yard debris pile</i>	\$55 minimum
<i>Items containing Freon</i>	Additional \$20 per item
<i>Tube TVs</i>	\$10 per item

Electronics Recycling

Residents can drop off their used, broken or obsolete electronics at Public Works (3210 Cumberland Drive) on the 3rd Saturday of each month from 8 am to 12 pm. A \$10 fee is required for TV and computer monitors. Commonly recycled items include computer equipment, media equipment, small appliances, power tools, TVs, phones, and batteries. Please don't forget to erase your hard drive prior to recycling!

Hazardous Waste

There are certain household products that the City cannot collect. Items labeled toxic, poisonous, corrosive, flammable, combustible or irritant **CANNOT** be placed into your trash or recycling carts. Most of these hazardous items can be disposed of at DeKalb County Hazardous Waste events or the Center for Hard to Recycle Materials (CHaRM) in Atlanta, GA.
