## PAC Working on Public Safety Building Mural

CAs a part of the Chamblee Arts Master Plan, the City established a Public Art Commission (PAC) to assist in managing public art and fostering creativity. The PAC met March 17.

The committee has been working for the past several weeks on a mural that will go on a wall at the Public Safety Building (PSB). They have received community input, and now proposals. The PAC will be releasing the proposals for the PSB soon for the public to view and vote on. We've got great proposals and we're excited to release the options to the public. The PAC reviewed the updates to the proposed Lumen (new development on Chamblee Dunwoody Road/Chamblee Dunwoody Way) parking deck art panels. They were pleased with the updates and gave their approval to move forward with the proposed renderings.

The consultants for the Art Center Business plan have been narrowed down to three possible candidates. Staff is currently working to select a candidate to propose to council.
