PAC Selects Mural Proposal Winner

The City Council voted Tuesday, April 20, 2021, to approve all four mural proposals and asked the Public Art Commission (PAC) to make the final determination for which one would be on the Public Safety Building. At their regularly held meeting on April 21, the PAC approved NCSB Studios as the muralist for the Public Safety Building. The PAC also is tasked with determining locations for the other four murals and will be working on that at their next meeting.

The PAC discussed several other projects and budgetary constraints. The commission is working on prioritizing projects and determining funding for projects moving forward. They discussed having a brainstorming meeting soon in anticipation for fall budget planning.

One of the other projects the PAC is considering is a decorative fence project on Peachtree Road across from Pierce Drive. The fence would be a metal-work sculpture that would serve as a screen. Funding would need to be found for the project should it be determined this is a priority project. The next meeting for the PAC is May 19, 2021.
