CITY OF CHAMBLEE NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE
Chamblee maintains millage rate for 2022, property assessments rise

June 2, 2022 — The City of Chamblee intends to maintain the millage rate of 6.25 mills in 2022. This is the same rate as adopted in 2021, 2020, and 2019. In 2019, Chamblee City Council approved an additional homestead exemption of \$20,000 for a total homestead exemption of \$50,000.

Due to an increase in DeKalb County's reevaluation of real property tax assessments, maintaining the proposed millage rate of 6.25 mills will result in an increase in property taxes by 5.68 percent over the rollback millage rate. The rollback rate is the amount a millage rate would need to be reduced to generate the same amount of tax revenue as the year before. The 2022 general fund budget of \$27,114,861 was adopted in December 2021 based on an anticipated millage rate of 6.25 mills.

The City of Chamblee will host three public hearings for the 2022 millage rate. The first two public hearings will be held at Chamblee City Hall located at 5468 Peachtree Road, Chamblee, Georgia on Monday, June 13, 2022, at 11:45 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. The final public hearing will be held at the Chamblee Public Safety Building, located at 4445 Buford Highway NE, Chamblee, GA 30341 on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.

After the final public hearing, the millage rate will be formally adopted at the regular city council meeting on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at the Chamblee Public Safety Building.
